Interested bidders are encouraged to attend a pre-bid meeting to be held on Tuesday, August 8, 2017 at 10:00 am, at the Worcester County Department of Public Works, Administrative Office, 6113 Timmons Road, Snow Hill, Maryland 21863, at which the project scope and Bid Documents will be discussed in depth and Bidders' questions will be answered.

Sealed bids will be accepted until 1:00 pm, Monday, August 21, 2017 in the Office of the County Commissioners, Room 1103 - Worcester County Government Center, One West Market Street, Snow Hill, Maryland 21863, at which time they will be opened and publicly read aloud. Envelopes shall be marked "Meadow Bridge Road Bridge Replacement Project" in the lower left-hand corner.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of opening thereof. After opening, bids will be forwarded to the Public Works Department for tabulation, review and recommendation to the County Commissioners for their consideration at a future meeting. In awarding the bid, the Commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids, waive formalities, informalities and technicalities therein, and to take whatever bid they determine to be in the best interest of the County considering lowest or best bid, quality of goods and work, time of delivery or completion, responsibility of bidders being considered, previous experience of bidders with County contracts, or any other factors they deem appropriate.
