ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids, in duplicate, for the construction of the **Inflow and Infiltration Removal Phase I Project** will be received by the **City of Crisfield, 319 West Main Street, Crisfield, Maryland, 21817** until **11:00 AM** local time on **October 27, 2020** at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project consists of lining approximately 150 LF of 10-inch and 5,500 LF of 12-inch sanitary sewer, 200 vertical feet of sanitary sewer manholes rehabilitation, and other miscellaneous related work as indicated within the contract documents. Work includes furnishing all equipment, material, and labor for the work described in the contract document drawings and specifications.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of **8:00 AM to 5:00 PM**, and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents also may be examined at the **City of Crisfield, 319 West Main Street, Crisfield, Maryland 21817, (410) 968-1333**, Mondays through Fridays between the hours of **9:00 AM to 4:00 PM**.

Bidding Documents are available on compact disc (as portable document format (PDF) files) and printed form. They may be obtained from the Issuing Office either via in-person pick-up or via mail, upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment for the Bidding Documents. The non-refundable cost of Bidding Documents is \$100.00 per set, payable to Davis, Bowen & Friedel, Inc., plus any non-refundable shipping charge. Upon Issuing Office's receipt of payment, Bidding Documents will be sent via the prospective Bidder's delivery method of choice; the shipping charge will depend on the shipping method chosen. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the prospective Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A pre-bid conference will be held at **11:00 AM** local time on **October 13, 2020** at the **Corbin Library, 4 East Main Street, Crisfield, Maryland 21817**. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory.

Section 746 of Title VII of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 (Division A - Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2017) and subsequent statutes mandating domestic preference applies an American Iron and Steel requirement to this project. All listed iron and steel products used in this project must be produced in the United States. The term "iron and steel products" means the following products made primarily of iron or steel: lined or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal castings, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete, and construction materials. The de minimis and minor components waiver, as applicable, apply to this contract.

This project is being funded through agencies such as the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) and United States Department of Agriculture-Rural Development (USDA-RD). All requirements in regard to Minority/Women/Disadvantage Business Enterprises shall apply as indicated in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS. All Bidders must utilize to the greatest extent feasible minority/women/disadvantage

businesses and will not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, or national origin in considering minority/women/disadvantage businesses for subcontracting and/or material supplies.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
